- Conduct operations in compliance with relevant local environmental legislation, regulations, licences and other requirements.
- Demonstrate, via external verification, compliance with external industry standards applicable to each operating region. Standards include: ISO 9001, ISO 14001, OHSAS 18001, AS/NZS 4801 (Australia only) and R2 (US only). CtL Australia strives to comply with R2 standards which is currently managed and monitored internally with a target to achieve certification in 2017.
- CtL also strives to comply with eStewards standards globally. This is managed and monitored internally.
- Ensure that hazardous and other focus materials are identified and managed locally adhering to the Basel Convention to protect human health and ensuring environmentally sound management of product(s).
- Identify and manage environmental risk to prevent pollution and achieve continual improvement of environmental performance through best practice.
- Provide a recycling solution for an industry where previously nearly all waste went to landfill or developing countries and by doing so our innovative approach is paying dividends for the environment, human health and business.
